

Stay in Thailand May – June 2014


The new school year started about half May in Thailand. We met the sponsored students and selected new ones for scholarship. Until now, already 342 students were sponsored by Belgisaan : on this way, they had the opportunity for a better future.



The selection of the new sponsored students happens by the school in collaboration with Belgisaan. We go visit their home and meet their family. There is so a good relationship with them.



We visited also the students of our "Food Program", including some new ones. Until now, 44 primary students joined this project, and so they don't need to study with an empty stomach. At home, they have often a lack of food.





The primary students of the school of Slijpe and the school "Tweesprong" of Handzame exchange drawings with them of the school of Nonthongnongwai and Bannarong. The most beautiful drawings receive a gift.



Lukas from Belgisaan visited the useful lavatory- and cleanwaterproject of the school of Bannarong, financed by the Belgian school Collège Notre-Dame Tournai. He saw that the students were very happy to use it.



We distributed a lot of clothes to the poor people of the village Dongwai-Donkwan.



We have daily meetings with the teachers of the schools. Sometimes, when students have problem, we consider their case. There is a good collaboration between the schools and Belgisaan.





In the schools where Belgisaan is active, our collaboration is very appreciated. We receive sometimes a thanks certificate from the school. This time, it was in the municipality school Tessaban 5 of Udon Thani.

During the weekend we organized a trip to Nongkhai , at the Mekong river.



Daily we visited the poor people to give them help and assistance.



Lumchai Boumho, 17 years old, receives scholarship and so he can continue to study at Esarn Technology College Udon Thani. His father died 4 years ago. His mother try to survive by singing in restaurants. He is a good student.

His house will soon be seized by the bank. In the morning he has to get up soon to make some small works in the temple before go to school.

Weerapam Yankham, 13 years old, lost his parents soon after he was borned. He lives with his grandmother and his cousins. His grandmother is street saleswoman. . 8 people live in her home. He lives 10 km far from school. Now he gets scholarship and so he can start his secondary school. His foster parent gave money so that he can go shopping with his : it was the first time that he went to the supermarket and bought a lot of useful things, for himself and for at home. Also material for drawing as it is his hobby and he can do it very well.
